




# Dung Beetle Assessment Site Scorecard

<b>Average Site Score:</b> An average of the top 50% pat scores (highest scoring half) Take the average score (scored up to 50) & multiply x2	<b>%</b>

An average site score over 50% is moderate health & over 80% very healthy for dung beetles

Use this chart to differentiate the types of beetles



## Useful Quick Notes On Measures:

A pat = 1 cow pat = 1 horse pat = 12 sheep dropping patches = Other equivalent

6 pat samples from each of: Sun and Shade

Dung too liquid to pick up – don't sample & record pat dung type 'Runny' for scoring

Lots of holes on the underside of dung is a hole approximately every 1 cm

Holes more than 1.5cm wide are about a size you can fit an adult's little finger in
